



Lawn Bowling

Revised November 2015

1. **Age Categories:** Men and Women 55 +
 2. **Events:**
 - (a) Mixed Fours (Two men and two women)
 - (b) Men's Pairs
 - (c) Women's Pairs
 - (d) Mixed Triples (two men and one woman OR two women and one man)
 3. **Participation:**
 - (a) Maximum 11 participants per zone. Either 5 men and 6 women or 6 men and 5 women.
 - (b) **Each participant may enter more than one of the events listed in Rule 2, but may not enter both the fours and the triples events.**
 4. **Competition:**
 - (a) Bowls B.C. Rules will be in effect.
 - (b) Round Robin Play will be used.
 - (c) If less than four teams are entered in any event a double round robin format will be adopted.
 - (d) **Where ever possible, no participant shall be required to play more than three games in one day.**
 - (d) Twelve-end games with a 2-hour time limit.
 - (e) A burnt end is a played end except for the last end, which will be played over if within the 2-hour time limit.
 - (f) When the "Time up" signal is given, only the end being played shall be completed.
 - (1) The "jack" cannot be delivered after the "time up" signal.
- NOTE:** Lawn Bowlers should wear white but the team may wear shirts in Zone colors. Bowlers must wear smooth, flat-soled shoes.
5. **Placement:**
 - (a) Two points will be scored for a win and one point for a tie.
 - (b) Final placement in the standings will be calculated by the total of Game Points (wins and ties). Where points are equal, the tie shall be broken by the differential of shots for and against for the entire Round Robin, with the maximum differential for any one game of 10. If the teams are still equal, the tie shall be broken by the number of ends won.
 6. **Medals:**

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the top three teams in each event.
 7. **Zone Playoffs:**
 - (a) Above rules shall apply to Zone Playoffs.
 - (b) All Zone Participants must be registered with the Zone.
