## Equestrian

*Revised February 2018*

1. **Age Categories:** There will be no separation between Men and Women.  
Men and Women: 55 to 64, 65+
2. **Events:**  
Each discipline will offer events compatible with facilities.
  - Driving (not in 2018 Games)
  - Dressage
  - Mountain Trail
  - Western Dressage
  - Western Performance – Ranch Riding Horse, Ranch Trail Horse
3. **Participation:**
  - (a) There will be no limit to the number of participants within each age category or Zone.
  - (b) All Participants must be Provincial Sport Organization (PSO) members.
  - (c) **One horse per participant. One horse may be shared by two different participants. Participants must compete in all events with the same horse. Participants may compete in a maximum of two discipline divisions in one category or level. Tests, classes or patterns will be ridden each day. The medal results will be determined by total of combined scores from all discipline events. Where there are less than 3 participants in a category or discipline division, the category or discipline division groups may be combined for the final medal standings.**
4. **Competition:**
  - (a) All participants are required to follow discipline competition rules ~~regarding equipment and attire.~~
  - (b) Each participant will be assigned an **entry number which must be worn at all times during the competition.**
  - (c) Rising trot is **optional in all dressage tests at the discretion of the competitor and will not be penalized by the Judge.**
  - (d) All equestrian events will adhere to Horse Council of BC rules.
5. **Fees**  
Participants are responsible to pay any stable **or camping fees required to the facility on arrival.**
6. **Medals:**  
Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each discipline-specific event.

Medal presentations will take place at the end of the competition at the Equestrian Facility.
