



KELOWNA ACCREDITATION INFORMATION

WHEN TO CHECK IN / 'NO SHOW' CLASSIFICATION

Accreditation for participants and supporters will take place at the Capital News Centre located at 4105 Gordon Drive, Kelowna on Tuesday, September 10 and Wednesday September 11. A reminder that all participants MUST check in with their zone registration table prior to picking up their accreditation package from the sport tables.

Tuesday, September 10

2 pm to 8 pm

Participants are required to accredit the day before competition in their sport begins. Participants registered in the sports listed below MUST accredit by 8:00 pm on Tuesday, September 10 or be classified as “no shows” and unable to compete at the Games.

Wednesday, September 11

Noon to 5 pm

All participants competing in other sports not listed above must accredit by 5:00 pm on Wednesday, September 11 or be classified as “no shows” and unable to compete at the Games.

If unable to attend in person, participants must arrange to have their accreditation package picked up for them. A designated person may pick up a team's package, or a partner's, or two individual's using the “Accreditation Package Pick up form”. The designated individual must show ID and sign for the package.
