Zone 2
Policy Regarding Sport Expenses and Uniforms**

Preamble

1. Subject to the availability of funds, Zone 2 of the BC Seniors Games Society will:
 - a. cover some expenses incurred in the conduct of Zone 2 Playdowns;
 - b. reimburse some of the costs of clinics, practice venue rentals, officials and equipment required to prepare for the Games; and
 - c. provide funds for appropriate uniforms for participants in the Games.
2. All proposed expenditures require prior approval by the Zone 2 Board.

Playdowns and Training

3. Sport Coordinators are to submit their requests for funds in a timely fashion through the Sport Chair for presentation to the Board at the next regular meeting.
4. Playdowns. Zone 2 will pay for most reasonable expenses associated with the conduct of Playdowns required to select participants for the Games. All participants in Zone 2 Playdowns must be paid-up members of the BC Seniors Games Society (BCSGS).
5. Training. Zone 2 will reimburse up to \$450 per sport for clinics, practice venue rentals, officials and equipment to prepare Zone 2 teams for the Games. To be eligible for reimbursement, teams and individuals must be registered to participate in the upcoming Games.

Uniforms

6. Requests for sport-specific uniforms must be submitted by the Sport Coordinator, through the Sport Chair, to the Board before June 15th.
 - a. All requests must include: proposed design, source and total costs.
 - b. All uniforms must reflect the Zone 2 colours – predominantly white with dark green trim.

- c. The uniform is to show “Zone 2” and, where practical, should incorporate the BC 55-Plus Games Logo.
 - d. Sponsorship patches must conform with the BCSGS Policy regarding sponsor’s logos:
 - Patches must be less than 3 inches by 3 inches and affixed on either the left or right front of the shirt or left or right sleeve.
 - There can be no sponsorship referring to: tobacco, alcohol, politics, discrimination, religion or pornography.
 - e. Zones may use the BCSGS’s Logo on Zone jackets and team uniforms; however the logo must stand on its own, on the right-hand side of the jacket/team uniform. The design and colour must be exactly the same as the official logo. If it is not possible to replicate the colours, light grey may be used. Zone numbers must be at least 1-1/4” below the BCSGS Logo.
7. Priority for funding uniforms will be given to:
- a. Sports submitting a request for the first time.
 - b. New participants in an existing sport.
 - c. New sports [added to the current Games]
 - d. Replacement uniforms – for damaged uniforms.
8. Uniforms will be given to the individual. However, it is expected that uniforms in good condition would be returned to Zone 2 [appropriate Sport Coordinator] should the individual no longer participate in the Games.
